In this manuscript, presented latest and a more specific classic characteristics and complications on tuberculous meningitis with hydrocephalus undergone fluid diversion. From this research, we found that 75% from 28 patient were from infancy age group (0-12 months old). Other 25% were from macrocephal group; about 64% from all samples were patient with fair nutritional status. Interestingly, patients with *frontal bossing* characteristics were only 17%, and there was almost none patient with hydrocephalus characteristics. This study finds no complication, like infection, phlebitis and *exposed shunt* in TBM patients with hydrocephalus, receiving fluid diversion therapy in our center.
