However, they also agreed that the use of cellphones should be limited, considering the effects that would be caused if they continued to stare at the cellphone screen, as many as 88% agreed that cellphone use should be limited and 12% disagreed that cellphones should be limited.

It has been proven that cellphones are very important for today's life, the question we ask is that whether every activity of the respondent requires a cellphone, their answer is 52% agree that cellphones can make their activities easier while 40% of them also stated that every activity does not require a cellphone and the rest answered no. always because the activity is not only from the cellphone. however, 88% of respondents agreed that cellphones can cause quite dangerous side effects and some people also added that when using cellphones for too long will cause headaches and eye pain (Dadi, 2014; Sidiq, 2019).

In this day and age technology is very easy to access, all people can use technology very easily. However, there is some controversy regarding the addiction of minors to cellphones. And here are some opinions about minors who are addicted to cellphone technology:

The conclusion from the above statement: that many young people and some people from class A do not agree that underage children are addicted to playing cellphones and the role of parents must be very carefully considered (Sudrajat et al., 2019). This is also supported by Kwon, et al explaining that mobile phone addiction is an addictive behavior or attachment to cellphones that allows social problems such as withdrawal and difficulties in daily activities.

The role of parents in guiding children still needs more attention, from 23 respondents' answers, many agreed that many parents still let their children play cellphones without
