



TYPES OF CHARACTERIZATIONS OF THE MAIN CHARACTER IN THE “FRIENDS WITH BENEFITS” FILM

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ABSTRACT

This study aimed to determine the three dimension of characterizations used to describe the main character in the film Friends with Benefits. Jamie Rellis and Dylan Harper are the two main characters that focused on this discussion. The film Friends with Benefits is the data source in this study. In collecting the data through library research by viewing films, reading scripts, and taking notes. In analyzing the data, the qualitative method is used and presented descriptively based on the theory adopted in this study. The theory used in this study is the theory of literature proposed by Wellek and Warren (1949) about characterization. The results of this study showed that only three characterization dimensions were analyzed. In presenting these dimensions, this study presents an overview and/or dialogue from the film. There are three dimensions of the characterization of the main character analyzed in this study: physiological, sociological, and psychological. These physical and psychological characteristics combine to build up Jamie Rellis and Dylan Harper, a romantic person in the film Friends with Benefits.

INTRODUCTION

Literature is an artistic and constructive practice that reflects the social reality with a sense of aesthetic values. According to Wellek and Warren (1949: 3), the term literature is most appropriately applied to literary arts, namely literature as an imaginative work. As with imaginative works, the author uses beautiful language as a form of creativity.

Literary work is a view of life in a social environment. This view occurs because the author cannot be separated from certain social ties in social society. Good literature does not only record the realities that exist in society. Literature can be seen as a social phenomenon. The literature presents life and life consists mostly of social realities (Wellek and Warren, 1993: 98).

Apart from novels, poetry, short stories, and drama are also films included in literary works. Films are also called movies. Films are one of the most literary works since films offer a mixture of music, literature, drama, and visual arts combined as a platform for conveying entertainment, social, educational, and commercial knowledge.

According to the Oxford Learner's Dictionaries (2020), a film is a series of moving pictures recorded with a sound that tells a story, watched at a cinema or on a television or other device. Most authors create a reality-based film; the film will reflect thoughts about all life in human life. We can learn how the characterization of the story influences the audience.

Characterization is called a method of developing and shaping a character in a fictional work. By this definition, characterization means a fair portrayal of the characters who participate in the story by their behaviour.

This study attempts to determine the types of characterizations used to describe the main character in the film *Friends with Benefits*. This film is chosen because the author believes that it could provide much information about characterization related to the characters' conflict so that the film is fascinating to analyse.

The film *Friends with Benefits*, directed by Will Gluck, is an American romantic comedy in 2011. The story is as follows: Jamie Rellis is a New York City head-hunter trying to recruit Dylan Harper for her client, a Los Angeles-based art director. Therefore, under the title *Types of Characterizations of the main character in the film Friends with Benefits*, the researcher investigates against or based on the background above.

Based on the background above, the problem of this study is "What types of characterizations are used to describe the main characters in the film *Friends with Benefits*?"

METHODS

This study uses the film entitled *Friends with Benefits* as the data source published in 2011 and directed by Will Gluck. This study emphasizes the analysis of the types of characterization are used to describe the main character in the film *Friends with Benefits*.

The Theory of Literature proposed by Wellek and Warren (1949) which talk about characterization is used to support this analysis.

Characterization

The method of shaping a character is characterization. It's relevant for all characters. The approach must be memorable and complicated to appear thrilling and attractive. On the other hand, characterization is a means of representing or presenting a human character in a story. Through speech and action, the individual states themselves so that these instruments can recognize that characterization.

Types of Characterization

According to Wellek and Warren (1949:221), there are three dimensions of characterization such as physiological, sociological, and psychological.

1. Physiological Dimension

Commonly, physiology is the study of humans or specifically human appearance. The physiological dimension is simply concerned with the aspect of physical description such as sex, height/weight, skin, eyes, hair color, and other physical appearance.

2. Sociological Dimension

Sociology means the social life of a person such as social background, class, occupation, environment, education, religion, etc. The sociological aspect is based on the social background such as social activity, nationality, and religion. It represents in the social interaction with other people in daily life.

3. Psychological Dimension

Psychological means the author's psychological research, as the form and as an entity, or the study of the creative process or the study of the forms and laws of psychology present in the literature of works, or, finally, the influence of literature on the audience. The psychological of the characters can be observed through their attitude, feeling, thought, mentality, dream, ego, temperament, and emotion.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

RESULT

As the result of the analysis of the data, the writer found 6 types of characterization based on the theory proposed by Wellek and Warren (1949), which are Physiological, Sociological, and Psychological from each main character in the film *Friends with Benefits*.

DISCUSSION

The writer discussed the data concerned with the research problem in which is to find out the types of characterization of the main characters in the film *Friends with Benefits*. The writer found two main characters in this film, they are Jamie Rellis and Dylan Harper.

Types of Characterizations of Main Character in the film *Friends with Benefits*
