The statistical Data mention that the promiscuity among the younger generation AS very worrying: First, 10 of 7 young women and 8 young men the age of a dozen years has become one with the other do free association. Second, young women are more aggressive and assertive, that is one of the young women mix freely with 4 friends of his.

Third, every minute there are 2 pregnant teens, teen pregnancy reached 40% of all pregnancies nationally, of 3 the birth of one of them out of wedlock. In the year 2017 recorded 1.200.000 pregnancy outside of marriage and a new half who successfully aborted. Fourth, the spread of venereal disease among teenagers in U.S. is increasing, especially AIDS. Every minute 3 people contracting the Virus HIV causes

the disease AIDS.¹ Today AIDS is the number one killer among teens and the younger generation (Dr. Harold Jaffe, 1994). Another prediction mentions in the year 2019, AIDS is the number one killer above heart disease.² Fifth, although the teenagers are given sex education in schools and taught how to prevent pregnancy and venereal disease, it turns out that sex education given backfired, venereal disease is increasing and pregnancy out of wedlock more and more.

The results of the evaluation showed it turns out that 74% of them did not use condom and contraceptives other, 65% do anal sex. What about the case in Indonesia? Also very alarming occurs setback that befell a generation of young people, the meaning of: increasing the number of those who smoke, use drugs, violations of sexual and pornography, fights and so on. The Data is quite alarming for example, according to the survey of Social Economy: 2018, 23% of the population aged 10 years and above have the habit of smoking. More than 50% started at the age of 15-19 years. Also 2018 the results of a survey of Institutions

Tackling the Problem of Smoking stated that 59% of men and 4.8% of women aged 10 years and over "now smoking", at least a day for at least 3 months. The habit of smoking is one of the door become a user of narcotics. The division of the large of drug users are smokers. Currently in Indonesia, at least, there are 5 million drug addicts in which 70% of his 14-15 years old. An increasing number of patients also appear from the user by the number of patients treated in hospital kecandungan drugs for example: in the year 2015 is 1,500 patients, 2016 to be 3,500, 2017 to be 5.847, 1999 be 9.852 and until June 2018 existing 7.512 patients. The abuse of narcotics and psychotropic substances has been reaching out to the younger generation to get to the village as well as entry to the economically weak.

In addition to the above problems, the young generation and also the range will be a violation of sexual and pornography, in addition to being a rape victim. On a rasia students in order to capture the users and dealers of narcotics are also found condoms, DVD pictures porn. The increased use of

narcotics and sexual transgressions, the real effect on the increase in the number of addicts with HIV/AIDS reached 7 people. Also about the fights of students increasing course quality and kwantitasnya. According to Kompas, in Jakarta 2015/2016 recorded 93 cases, in 2017, the 230 cases, and in 2018 the victims of the brawl be the 26 cases, 56 heavy injuries and 103 wound teen. And according to survey Research Institutions and the Development Problems of Narcotics and the Young Generation of Indonesia, it is known that of the 100 cases of brawl are infected with the drug.

Prof. Dr. Fawzia Aswin, professor of the Faculty of Psychology UI, said that the data Polda Metro Jaya shows that during the year 2018 occurs 193 the case of the brawl students in 257 schools in Jakarta. Means the average student brawls in the capital once every 2 days brawl, as a result 35 students were killed, 204 wounded and 478 of the vehicle is damaged.

From the above examples when the society being permissive under the pretext of "freedom" and human RIGHTS, or what excuse to let the style of life that continues, it can already imagine how the shape or structure of the family in the future? Then, is there any form of family as we profess now this? Which in turn use SCIENCE without FAITH instead of bringing welfare, but rather the destruction of a social order,

the family. Isn't the scholar Einstein said, "Science without religion equals blind, and religion without science is the same with the lame?" Research proves that the development of children from the results of the extramarital relationship will not develop properly as well as the risk to behave in a deviant larger than the children born of both parents who are legally

married.

Over here necessary Discipleship digenerasi millenial, it cannot be denied that discipleship is one of the elements that can bring the growth of the faith in the generation now this. Discipleship is one of the tasks the existence of the church in the face of the earth, that is faith formation. The church should be able to be leaders who make disciples. Auo Nainggolan in his book entitled "Leadership, the Proclamation of the Word and the Church that is Growing in the Era of Millennial" and wrote that "Leadership quality in the days of millennial is not just enough only with the ability that its legality based on the pattern of a brilliant mind alone but have to combine the quality of faith or a spiritual quality that have an impact and be consistent in the service that pleases God.

Even death cannot touch Christ's church because He has overcome it. In other words, discipleship is very important for all groups, not limited by age. The emphasis of the Lord Jesus on His disciples so that they would go only to convey the gospel of the Kingdom of God and its centrality to repentance and forgiveness of sins, cast out all evil spirits, heal all sicknesses.⁴

Aulen's perspective more concretely says the New Testament church has two realities, both the Pentecostal congregation

In order to complete this research, the descriptive method will be used during the process to describe the research activities carried out on certain objects, namely discipleship at GBI Sukawrna Bandung in a clear and systematic manner. The task of this research is to use a qualitative type with a descriptive method that is used to study the problem and get a deeper meaning about discipleship with the pattern of the Kingdom of God (the Kingdom of God).

By paying attention to the traits inherent in the lives of this millennial generation, at least their way of life that emphasizes smart and skilled work is a positive side of their life, which is called generation Y. But just as there is a positive side, there is also a negative side to this generation. They need a meaningful life in the midst of a fast flow of change so that they are able to live in balance. If it is not obtained, the lives of those who are enslaved by social media technology will lead them to a meaningless life. This can be seen from the trend of

suicide and lifestyle as a drug user to devian behavior.
