2. RESEARCH METHOD

The research was conducted by first conducting a survey to adolescents regarding the impact of technology and information on adolescents in social life. The survey using a Likert questionnaire was distributed using a google form which was given to teenagers in the family and around the house. It is possible that on this scale, there are numbers but only as a sequence. Thus, the analysis is only in the form of frequency (amount) or it can be in proportion (percentage). The second is by using the most analysis or mode (Syofian 2015).

3. RESULTS AND DISCUSSIONS

This study focuses more on the impact of communication and information technology on adolescents in social life, there are 34 respondents from students of the Islamic University of Nusanta Bandung and students from other universities in Bandung. The following is the percentage obtained from respondents regarding the impact of information and communication technology on adolescents in social life from each of the indicators proposed in the form. The first is about whether when you wake up the first time you see your cellphone, respondents agree, 68.6% of respondents do not agree, 14.3% of respondents disagree, 5.7% of respondents strongly disagree, 11.4% of respondents agree in this statement.

Based on the survey, there is a statement that is whether the impact of technology and communication has a negative impact. In this case, 71.4% of students do not agree about this, in fact students agree. 14.3% of students disagreed 11.4% after knowing the impact of technology, but 2.9%% of students did not strongly agree if technology and communication had a negative impact. When the presence of technology can help in everyday life, 91.3% of respondents agree with the statement, 2.9% of respondents do not agree, 0% of respondents disagree, 0% of respondents strongly agree in this statement, students agree that technology can facilitate or help in everyday life.

Now it has often happened that the name of crime is not only thieves and robbers, but technology can also be troubling for everyone but, students can also feel the crime of technology in today's era where our important data is hacked or hacked. The respondent's response to the question/questionnaire is, "Nowadays there are many crimes in technology, do you think it can bother you", 85.7% of respondents answered agree. Furthermore, the level of less agree is 11.4%. This condition is included in the unfavorable category. It means that students feel uneasy about online crime. And strongly disagree, 2.9%. And at the lowest level disagree 0% with the opinion of the respondent.

Regarding the positive impact of technology and communication among students, the form shows that, 28.6% of respondents answered agree and the lowest level was disagree and strongly disagree 2.9%. These conditions include that there is very little impact of technology among teenagers and students. (source data taken through a questionnaire). Questionnaires or questionnaires can be referred to as written interviews because the contents of the questionnaire are a series of written questions addressed to the respondent and filled out by the respondent himself.

In addition, in terms of impact, there are ten indicators to measure the level of impact of technology and communication on adolescents in social life, from the survey results obtained data as contained in the table below.
