In this study, we found five themes that describe the organizations or communities that play the role in the provision of complementary foods, the process of giving the foods, environmental conditions related to complementary foods, and the existence of optimal complementary feeding practices during a disaster. The process of giving complementary foods that occurs does not escape the influence of Indonesian culture, namely mutual cooperation (*gotong royong*). These findings are useful for areas that vulnerable to natural disaster, can be used as in-depth assessment of a disaster mitigation especially in nutrition areas, and to provide specific interventions according to these problems.
