This research uses descriptive method. The aimed is to know the use of E-Pen and Computer by the English teacher at Elementary School. The data collection and data processing procedure was done using class observation, interview the teacher and documentation. The analysis was done by comparing the theories and the factual data found.

The result found that during teaching and learning activities, teacher used computer in pre-activity to stimulate students' attention in the beginning of the lesson. The function of computer is to show the video, audio/song and Microsoft power Point/slides, then reflected into whiteboard. The teacher used E-Pen in whilst activity, it was very helpful to make the students knows right pronunciation from the native speakers. The teacher's way when used the E-Pen by touching it to the textbook then the E-Pen will speak it out and was heard by whole class clearly. Using E-Pen and Computer in teaching and learning process is satisfying. By using E-Pen and Computer, the students can master vocabulary and pronunciation. Using E-Pen and Computer in the classroom makes the class more interesting, more active, more motivated in learning and easier to grasp the lesson.

# INTRODUCTION

# RESEARCH RESULT

The research aimed to describe the use of E-Pen and Computer by the English teacher at the fifth grade of SDN Angsau 4, Pelaihari. ## Results of the Observation

There were four meetings of teaching learning process which was attended by the researcher. In the process of teaching, teacher always used E-Pen and Computer.

# The Way the Teacher use the E-Pen and Computer

# **Class Observation**

The observation was conducted every Wednesday, in 4<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>st</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> September 2019. The duration of each meeting was 2 x 35 minutes. The teaching and learning activity did in the classroom. The theme of the lesson was "On





the weekend and Pet the pets" and the topic was "It's time for the film, Sites in Taman Mini Indonesia Indah, and Go to a pet shop". The information Technology used by the teacher were Computer and E-Pen.

During teaching and learning activity, teacher used projector and speaker in pre-activity. The function of the projector is to show the video and Microsoft power Point/slides, then reflected into a whiteboard. And the function of the speaker is to make the voice clear and could be heard by all students in the classroom.

The teacher also used E-Pen in while activity that can attract students' attention, the teacher's way when used the E-Pen is simple, by touching it to the textbook then the E-Pen will speak it out and was heard by whole class clearly.

The researcher concluded that the teacher used the Computer and E-Pen well.

## Results of the Interview

Interview with the teacher was conducted on Wednesday, September 4<sup>th</sup> 2019. The researcher interviewed Mrs. Ririn Setiyaningsih, S.Pd. There were ten questions given in the interview about Information Technology. At the first question, she told some available Information Technology in SDN Angsau 4, Pelaihari, they are computer, laptop, LCD projector, E-pen, mobile devices and online media or internet. On the second question, she thought those Informtion Technology were enough to use in teaching learning activity. In the third question, she said that there were some budgets from school to the teacher for buying some Information Technology needed. At the fourth question, she said the Information Technology had an important role in teaching learning activity. At the fifth question, she said that teaching by using Information Technology cold attract students' attention and decrease student boredom, then, it also could facilitate students to comprehend the lesson, and could decrease energy spending for teacher. At the sixth question, the Information she consider and chose Technology used based on the material, condition or time, condition, in here means when the teaching and learning activity was conduct in the last hour of school when the students felt tired and needed attractive or interesting things she used the Information Technology. On the seventh question she said she always used Information Technology as media in every teaching and learning process. Today SDN Angsau 4, Pelaihari especially for the fifth grade students uses Kurikulum 2013. The English teacher states that: the standard competency of teaching English of SDN Angsau 4, Pelaihari especially for class 5 is to train the students to be able to communicate to others in English in simple conversation. In addition, the basic competence of teaching English is they can express the various feelings or senses.

# **Svllabus**

Syllabus is the description about the material of the table of content that should be taught. The syllabus for fifth grade students of SDN Angsau 4, Pelaihari is based on *Kurikulum 2013*. In Kurikulum 2013, the students should master the English competence or the four language skills. They are listening, speaking, reading, and writing. But in this research, the researcher only focuses on the activity of teaching and learning English by using E-Pen andComputer. In teaching, the English teacher should look the syllabus.
