Meanwhile, according to Azhar Arsyad, media is everything that is used to convey material or information and can stimulate students' interest and attention in learning.

We can conclude from the expert opinion above that learning media are materials or aids for students and teachers in effective and efficient learning so that learning objectives can be achieved. Media is everything that is used to stimulate thoughts, attention, abilities, and skills that can encourage the learning process so that it can facilitate the achievement of a learning goal. Levie and Lents 1982 suggested 4 functions of the media:

1. Attention Function

Directing and attracting students' attention to focus on learning related to the visual meaning or text of the material displayed.

2. Cognitive function

Media in the form of pictures makes it easier to achieve the goal of remembering and understanding the messages stored in the picture.

3. Affective Function

Visual tools appear to be the most difficult branch of students when studying or reading illustrated texts.

4. Compensatory Function

Visual media provide context in order to understand the text to help students who are weak in reading.

So it can be concluded from the opinions of the experts above that learning media is a source for students to be able to get messages and information that has been given by educators in order to achieve learning objectives. According to Nana Sudjana and Ahmad Riau, there are various kinds of learning tools that can be used during learning:
