With the series of achievements achieved by the novel "Bay of Alaska ", the production house of MD Entertainment adapted it into a series. as many as 8 episodes and has been aired on We TV.

This review is a kind of document using the descriptive technique. The form of this research is qualitative. The approach used in this study is literary psychology. The data in this study are quotes in the form of words and sentences related to the main character and the conflicts he experiences taken from the novel: *Teluk Alaska*. Data collection techniques used are the documentary study technique. The data collection tool used in this study was human, namely the reviewers themselves as the main instrument and
